Summary of Issue

Missing Profile Data Field

When a user registers, it shows all of my customized s2Member data fields. After logging in and going to the "My Profile" page via this shortcode: [s2Member-Profile /], one of the data fields is missing.

Could the database be corrupted? I have had some other search related issues when searching members.

How do I troubleshoot this issue?

Details of Issue

When a logged in user selects "My Profile", they are presented with profile data fields where they can change.
